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The project partners of EDU4future have developed a joint international methodology

The Slovak Chamber of Commerce and Industry, together with partners from / Germany, Czech Republic, Austria, Italy and Slovenia, completed the first stage of the EDU4future project, which output is the compilation of a joint international methodology for identifying processes of transferring Industry 4.0 requirements into the vocational education and training curricula.

The compilation of a joint international methodology is an important element for the successful mapping of situation in particular countries which allow comparing different ways of transferring "digital" labor market requirements to vocational education and training.

The godmother – a professional concept guarantor of the uniform international methodology is the [AFBB](#) – an educational agency from Dresden, which has been operating in the field of vocational and lifelong learning in the German environment for 30 years. In addition to the project partners [SOPK](#), [TREXIMA](#), [ConPlusUltra](#), [t2i – trasferimento tecnologico e innovazione s.c. a r.l.](#), [G&P svetovanje Gregor Jagodič](#) were involved to design process representatives of vocational schools and companies and other institutions. The methodology is available in 6 European languages.

In the upcoming period, the international team will face tasks related to mapping the processes of transferring needs of companies on "Industry 4.0" to the secondary education system across all sectors of the economy. Subsequently, will be carried out their mutual comparison, evaluation and processing of recommendations for public sector organizations, secondary schools, companies, clusters, etc..
